



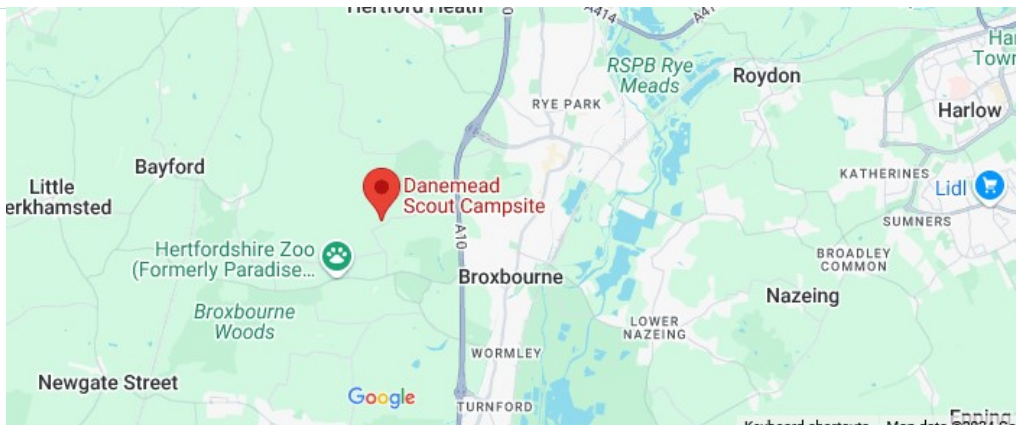

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR DELEGATES

Arrivals

If arriving by train, from Broxbourne Railway Station turn right into Station Road and proceed along to the T-Junction (A1170). Turn left and then immediately right into Park Lane. Follow the road uphill and around to Cock Lane T-Junction. Turn left and proceed for 1 mile. Just after an S-bend, the Danemead site entrance is on the right. It's approximately 2 miles from the station to the campsite.

If you would like to lift share, there is a lift sharing thread on the IOL Bushcraft PPG Facebook page.

On arrival at the site (from 4pm on Friday for weekend ticket-holders, or from 8am for day ticket-holders), please park your vehicle in the carpark and follow the signs to Hornbeam Lodge where you can check in. Delegates will receive a conference programme and name badge. Camping areas are approximately 100-200 yards from the car park. There is an area for Women's only camping if that is preferred. The site is suitable for hammocking.



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This is a catered event.

If you have booked indoor accommodation you will need to bring bedding (sleeping bag/duvet, sheet, pillow). There is one accessible indoor toilet and shower in Hornbeam Lodge and another toilet block with showers. There will be hot water and tea and coffee making facilities available all weekend inside —bring your travel mug.

What to bring:

- Sleeping bag and pillow (if sleeping indoors)
- Camping kit (if sleeping outdoors)
- Folding chair, stool or seat pad if you want to sit during outdoor workshops
- Plate, bowl, cutlery, mug
- Torch
- Notebook and pen
- Raffle item

As requested by our members, we are planning to run a few things at the conference for which we'll need delegates' help.

- 1) **Raffle.** On Saturday evening we would love to hold a non-monetary raffle. If you would like to participate, please bring along something that you have made or a useful resource that is plentiful in your area but might not be elsewhere (flints, tinders etc). You could bring a whittled item, something made from natural materials, a preserve, some hedge-row homebrew etc., the choice is yours. Bring something along; take something else home. Please hand in any raffle items when you check in at the start of the conference.
- 2) **Pre-loved Kit Sale.** If you have outdoor/bushcraft equipment that you no longer need, bring it along to the conference. Please attach a sticker or pin a piece of card to it stating your name and the price that you would like. We will allocate a space for items to be displayed. Items are displayed at your own risk.
