## Over 9000 young people took part in AAfH...

54% (over 5k) of the participant said they had a learning disability

12% (over 1k) said they had a physical disability A third of delivery took place in February & over half across March



## **Provider Learning - comments**

Overall feedback from providers has been positive, however improvements or future considerations they would have liked to have seen were:

- Less data capture many felt the process was very time consuming especially for charities and youth organisations and encountered resistance from group leaders and young people
- Longer lead time a number of organisations felt they were unable to fully build relationships with hard-to-reach groups and young people. Without a longer lead time they would have benefitted from being able to utilise the holiday periods.
- A short peer forum part way through to share feedback whilst this was done and was well received by those that attended, not all delivery partners and those working on the programme attended/ It may not have reached everyone, or it may have needed several sessions to maximise attendance
