IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR DELEGATES

If arriving by train, Mansfield Station is a 20 minute taxi drive from the venue.

If you would like to lift share, there is a lift sharing thread on the IOL Bushcraft PPG Facebook page.

On arrival at the site (from 4pm), please park your vehicle in the carpark (campervans may park next to the building) and head to the building where you can check in. Delegates will receive a conference programme and name badge. Camping areas are not far from the car park. The site is suitable for hammocking.

This is a catered event.

If you have booked indoor accommodation you will need to bring bedding (sleeping bag/duvet, sheet, pillow). There will be hot water and tea and coffee making facilities available all weekend inside —bring your travel mug.



As requested by our members, we are planning to run a few things at the conference for which we'll need delegates' help.

- 1) Inclusivity informal Show and Tell session. Bring along an item of equipment that you have adapted to cater for working with people with differing needs, or tell us how you have made adapting your working practices more inclusive. If you'd prefer to just listen, that's fine.
- 2) **Raffle.** On Saturday evening we would love to hold a non-monetary raffle. If you would like to participate, please bring along something that you have made or a useful resource that is plentiful in your area but might not be elsewhere (flints, tinders etc). You could bring a whittled item, something made from natural materials, a preserve, some hedgerow homebrew etc., the choice is yours. Bring something along; take something else home. Please hand in any raffle items when you check in at the start of the conference.
- 3) **Pre-loved Kit Sale.** If you have outdoor/bushcraft equipment that you no longer need, bring it along to the conference. Please attach a sticker or pin a piece of card to it stating your name and the price that you would like. We will allocate a space for items to be displayed. Items are displayed at your own risk.
- Delegates will be able to sign up for workshops each morning
- Delegates are permitted to bring sharp tools onto site
- Please bring along a folding chair, stool or seat pad if you think you might like to sit during outdoor workshops
