Who we are looking for:

Willowgate Adventure Centre is currently seeking a highly motivated, experienced and appropriately qualified Bushcraft / Living Heritage / Land Based instructor to join us on a full-time permanent basis as of March 2025. Could this be you?

The successful candidate for this post will bring a significant amount of expertise to the table and play a pivotal role in taking an established and respected operation to the next level in terms of delivery output and ongoing business development.

You should be well versed in the inner workings of an activity centre / outdoor education / heritage-based learning setting and hold demonstrable aptitude for delivering land-based programmes of education to a cross section of clientele including Stag / Hen groups, corporate events, schools, vulnerable adults and additional learning support needs. A full clean driving licence is essential as some offsite work may be required.

This is a brand-new post that will allow for creative input and development to assist with expansion across the existing land-based offering at Willowgate. This role will heavily focus on the growth of our existing Bushcraft offering with the addition of bringing to life a programme of living history and heritage associated with the ancient inhabitants of the local area, as well as many of the traditional countryside skills that have been relegated to the history books.

This Hybrid role will be split between practical hands-on delivery to a 5* level of a number of land-based activities to include Bushcraft, Archery, Air Rifle, Laser Clay and Fishing, as well as the development of living history and habitat protection aspects that tie into our wider charitable aims.

You will not be alone in your endeavours and will be expected to guide and qualify junior members of the team to deliver and interpret to the same high standard. You will also be working in close cooperation with the Operations Manager and existing staff to ensure best practice and effective communication at all levels.

We are seeking the right individual with a range of coaching qualifications with an emphasis on level 3 Bushcraft and curriculum appropriate history / environmental education teaching.

Proven leadership abilities as well as strong instructional and mentoring techniques are crucial to the success of this role. You will lead from the front with a calm, flexible and consistent approach and have the ability to respond positively to any challenges that may arise at a busy centre or on a field trip / expedition.
